Councillor Hoban said he would like either the Mayor or the Borough Manager to

contact this officer to see what his availability is going to be before we consider

hiring him.

MOTION TO AUTHORIZE THE BOROUGH SOLICITOR AND THE BOROUGH MANAGER TO DRAFT AND NEGOTIATE A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE UNION CITY LION'S CLUB: It was moved

the Borough Solicitor and the Borough Manager to draft and negotiate a license

agreement with the Union City Lion's Club. Motion carried.

up in regards to an Open Records Seminar that is going to be held on Tuesday, August

19th from 8:00 to noon.

MOTION TO ACCEPT NICK MONOCELLO'S RESIGNATION AS PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER WITH THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY: It was moved by

Councillor Kolaja and seconded by Councillor

Hoban to accept Nick Monocello's resignation as part-time police officer with the

Borough of Union City effective June 30th, 2014. Motion carried.

PUBLIC WORKS: Councillor Steadman said the streets department will be installing catch

basins on Warden Street.

He said Cross Paving has completed the paving on various streets of the Borough.
