PUBLIC HEARING FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINACE AND AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF HEMLOCK STREET SEPTEMBER 28, 2021

HEARING OF THE VISITORS REGARDING THE AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE.

Dennis Ploss, 44 Graves Street, Union City, spoke against the ordinance changing the set-back on fences. He referred to Section 307 A & B and then Section 609 of the Municipal Planning Code, on the requirements to change and ordinance. He pointed out that a resident must request the change.

Borough Council stated that there have been several residents that have requested the change.

Mike Farrell, 43 West High Street, Union City, Mike stated he was not in favor of changing the set-back for fencing.
