

**BOROUGH OF UNION CITY
ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
ORDINANCE NO. 1103**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY RELATING TO THE HIRING OF PART-TIME AND EXTRA POLICE OFFICERS FOR THE PROVISION OF REGULAR POLICE DEPARTMENT SERVICES FOR THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Union City operates the Union City Police Department which was properly established by Ordinance of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the current number of full-time police officers employed by the Union City Police Department is insufficient to handle the burden of providing police services to the Borough of Union City; and

WHEREAS, the Union City Police Department is desirous of hiring additional police officers; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of Union City has determined that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the Borough of Union City, and of the Union City Police Department, if the Department had the authority to hire part-time or extra officers when the need arises.

NOW THEREFORE, on this 13 day of December 2016, IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Union City, Erie County, Pennsylvania as follows:

Section 1. Short Title

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the “Union City Borough Part-Time Police Officer Ordinance.”

Section 2. Definitions.

The following words and phrases, when used in this part, shall have the meaning ascribed to them in this Section, except where the context or language clearly indicates or requires a different meaning. The singular shall include the plural and the masculine shall include the feminine and the neuter.

BOROUGH OF UNION CITY or BOROUGH—The area within the corporate limits of the Borough of Union City, Erie County, Pennsylvania.

BOROUGH COUNCIL—The governing board of the Borough of Union City.

PATROLMAN PART-TIME—A person whose appointment to the Union City Police Department is for a part-time position, that is, a position requiring on the average twenty (20) hours service or less per week and who has been commissioned with the aforementioned rank by

the Borough Council upon the request of the Mayor of the Borough of Union City and who is determined to be extra police who serve from time to time or on an hourly or daily basis pre 8 Pa.C.S. §1170.

UNION CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT --- The entity created by the Borough Council that implements and enforces the Borough's police powers within the Borough's corporate limits.

Section 3. Hiring of Patrolman Part-Time

A. The Borough Council, in accordance with the Pennsylvania Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. §101 *et seq*, shall have the authority and discretion to hire Patrolman Part-Time, upon recommendation of the Union City Police Department and as are necessary to supplement the general police force.

B. These Patrolman Part-Time are exempt from the civil service rules and regulations as they are determined to be extra police who serve from time to time or on an hourly or daily basis pre 8 Pa.C.S. §1170.

Section 4. Severability

In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance, it being the intent of the Borough Council that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Repealer

All ordinances, rules or regulations, or parts of ordinances, rules or resolutions in conflict herewith and the same are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be effective on Dec. 13th, 2016 and all calendar years thereafter unless repealed or modified by Ordinance of the Borough Council.
