BOROUGH OF UNION CITY ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NO. 1123

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY, **ERIE** COUNTY. PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1049, AS AMENDED, ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS AND IN THE MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE PENNSYLVANIA LEGISLATURE, ACT OF APRIL 29, 1959, P.L. 58, AS AMENDED, AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN SECTION 1(A), AND SECTION 14(B), ENTITLED PENALTIES, TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER, SEVERABILITY AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Borough Council ("Borough Council") of the Borough of Union City (the "Borough") wishes to amend Ordinance No. 1049, as amended, to further regulate parking within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of such an amendment is to further provide for the health and safety of residents and those who travel and park on streets within the Borough.

NOW THEREFORE on this 8th day of January, 2019 **IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Union City, Erie County, Pennsylvania as follows:

- **Section 1. Recitals.** That the above recitals are incorporated as if more fully set forth herein.
- **Section 2.** Subsection (a) of Section 1, entitled Definitions, of Ordinance No. 1049, as amended, is amended through the inclusion of underlined items and the deletion of items struck out, as follows:
 - (8) "Parking Enforcement Officer" Every police officer commissioned by the Borough of Union City, including the Chief of Police, and the Borough Streets Supervisor, AND THE PROGRAM MANAGER SENIOR OPERATOR.
- **Section 3.** Subsection (b) of Section 14, entitled Penalties, of Ordinance No. 1049, as amended, is amended through the inclusion of underlined items and the deletion of items struck out, as follows:
 - b. Any person accused of a violation of or found in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance may settle and compromise the claim against him or her for such illegal stopping, standing or parking by paying to the Borough the amount and on the schedule established, from time to time, by resolution f the Borough Council.—SUM OF FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00) WITHIN 24 HOURS OF THE TIME SUCH ALLEGED OFFENSE WAS COMMITTED OR THE SUM OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00) AFTER

24 HOURS OR THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY HAVE PASSED AFTER THE TIME SUCH ALLEGED OFFENSE WAS COMMITTED. A receipt shall be issued for all money so received and such money shall be turned over monthly to the Treasurer of the Borough to be used in the manner provided for the disposition of fines for traffic violations.

Section 4. In all other respects, Ordinance No. 1049, as amended, is confirmed and ratified.

Section 5. Repealer. All other ordinances, or sections of ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Severability

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council of the Borough of Union City that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 7. Effective Date

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective immediately as permitted by law.
