AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY, COUNTY OF ERIE AND STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA, PERTAINING TO THE OPERATION AND RIDING OF BICYCLES AND USE OF ROLLER SKATES OR ROLLER BLADES IN THE SAID BOROUGH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND HEREBY ENACTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME:

Section I. That bicycles may be operated or ridden and any person may use roller skates or roller blades, upon public streets and/or sidewalks of the said Borough, providing, however, that bicycle operators or riders and users of roller skates or blades shall dismount and push their bicycle and shall not use roller skates or blades on sidewalks on Main Street from High Street to Concord Street because of congestion and the safety of pedestrians. Bicycle operators or riders and users of roller skates or blades shall always yield the right of way to pedestrians and shall use all due care and caution to avoid injuring or annoying said pedestrians.

**Section II.** Only one person may ride on any bicycle, unless such bicycle is specifically designed to be operated by more than one person.

Section III. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be sentenced for the first offense to pay a fine of not more than five (5) dollars; for the second offense, to pay a fine of not more than ten (10) dollars; and for the third offense, to pay a fine of not more than twenty-five (25) dollars plus the cost of prosecution.

<u>Section IV</u>. This ordinance expressly repeals Ordinance No. 732 of the said Borough of Union City, County of Erie, and State of Pennsylvania, and all other ordinances or parts thereof conflicting herewith.
