

**BOROUGH OF UNION CITY, ERIE COUNTY, PA**

**ORDINANCE NO. 1049 (AS AMENDED)**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS AND IN THE MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY, ERIE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE PENNSYLVANIA LEGISLATURE, ACT OF APRIL 29, 1959, P.L. 58, AS AMENDED, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID REGULATIONS.

**IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Union City, Erie County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

**SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.**

a. The following words and phrases when used in this Ordinance shall, for the purpose of this Ordinance, have the meanings respectively ascribed to them as set forth herein:

(1) “Borough” – The Borough of Union City, Erie County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and its governing body thereto.

(2) “Crosswalk” –

(a) That part of a roadway at an intersection included within the connections of the lateral lines of the sidewalks on opposite sides of the highway measured from the curbs.

(b) Any portion of a roadway at an intersection or elsewhere distinctly indicated for a pedestrian crossing by lines or other markings on the road surface.

(3) “Curb Loading Zone” - A designated space adjacent to a curb reserved for the exclusive use of vehicles during the loading or unloading of passengers or materials.

(4) “Driver” - Every person who drives or is in physical control of a vehicle.

(5) “Highway” - The entire width between the boundary lines of every way publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel.

(6) “Motor Vehicle” - Every vehicle which is self-propelled, except one propelled solely by human power.

(7) “Park”, “Parked” or “Parking”:

- (a) When permitted, means the temporary storing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, off the roadway or along the roadway in a designated space, but not at any time between the curb or edge or the street and the sidewalk.
- (b) When prohibited, means the halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading materials or passengers.

(8) “Parking Enforcement Officer” – Every police officer commissioned by the Borough of Union City, including the Chief of Police, and the Borough Streets Supervisor.

(9) “Person” - Every natural person, firm, partnership, unincorporated association, corporation, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, limited liability company, business trust, or similar business entity.

(10) “Police Officer” - A natural person authorized by law to make arrests and issue citations for violations of law, as well as enforcement of the laws of the Borough and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

(11) “Private Road” or “Driveway” - Every way or place in private ownership and used for vehicular travel by the owner and those having express or implied permission from the owner, but not by other persons.

(12) “Railroad” - A carrier of persons or property upon cars or train cars, other than street cars, operated upon stationary rails.

(13) “Road” or “Roadway” – That portion of a highway improved, designed or ordinarily used for vehicular travel, exclusive of the berm or shoulder.

(14) “Sidewalk” - That portion of a street between the curb lines, or the lateral lines of a roadway, and the adjacent property lines, intended for use or foot-travel by pedestrians.

(15) “Stand” or “Standing” - Means the halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily for the purpose of, and while actually engaged in, receiving or discharging passengers.

(16) “Stop”, “Stopped” or “Stopping” - Means any halting even momentarily of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or a traffic control sign or signal.

(17) “Street” - A highway established and ordained by the Borough as a public street.

(18) “Vehicle” - Every device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, excepting devices used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

b. Official Time Standard - Whenever certain hours are named herein, they shall mean Eastern Standard Time or Daylight Savings Time as may be in current use in the Borough.

## **SECTION 2. METHOD OF PARKING**

a. Except as otherwise provided in this Ordinance, every vehicle stopped or parked upon a roadway where adjacent curbs are located shall be so stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels of such vehicle parallel to and within six (6) inches of the adjacent right-hand curb.

b. Unless otherwise provided in this Ordinance, every vehicle stopped or parked upon a roadway or berm adjacent to a roadway shall be so stopped or parked with the right-hand wheels of such vehicle parallel to and with the right-hand edge of said roadway or berm.

## **SECTION 3. STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING PROHIBITED**

a. Except when necessary to avoid conflict with other vehicles or traffic, or in compliance with law or the directions of a police officer or official traffic-control device, no person shall:

- (1) Stop, stand or park a vehicle:
  - (a) On the roadway side of any vehicle standing, stopped or parked at the edge of the curb of a street.
  - (b) On a sidewalk
  - (c) Within an intersection
  - (d) On a crosswalk
  - (e) Alongside or opposite any street excavation or obstruction when stopping, standing, or parking would obstruct traffic or potentially cause a hazard to vehicular travel in the Borough.
  - (f) Upon a bridge or any other elevated structure upon a highway or street.
  - (g) Upon any railroad tracks or any railroad crossing.

(h) At any place where official signs prohibit stopping, standing or parking.

(i) Between the curb of a street and the sidewalk.

b. Stop, stand or park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or passengers:

(1) In front of a public or private driveway

(2) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant

(3) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an intersection

(4) Within 20 feet upon the approach to any flashing signal, stop sign, or traffic control device or signal located at the side of a roadway.

(5) At any place where official signs prohibit parking, standing or stopping.

c. Park a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading materials or passengers:

(1) Within 50 feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing or railroad tracks.

(2) At any place where official signs prohibit parking.

d. No person shall move a vehicle not lawfully under his or her control into any such prohibited area or away from a curb such a distance as is unlawful, hazardous or obstructing other vehicles or traffic.

#### **SECTION 4. PARKING NOT TO OBSTRUCT TRAFFIC.**

No person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle upon a street in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than 10 feet of width of the roadway for free movement of vehicular traffic.

#### **SECTION 5. PARKING IN ALLEYS.**

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within an alley in such a manner or under such conditions as to leave available less than 10 feet of width of the roadway for the free movement of vehicular traffic, and no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle within an alley in such position as to block a driveway entrance to any abutting property.

#### **SECTION 6. PARKING FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES PROHIBITED.**

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any roadway for the principal purpose of:

- a. Displaying such vehicle for sale.
- b. Washing, greasing or repairing such vehicle except repairs necessitated by an emergency.

**SECTION 7. NO STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING NEAR HAZARDOUS OR CONGESTED PLACES.**

a. The Borough Secretary, in consultation with the Borough Chief of Police, is hereby authorized to determine and designate by proper signs places or areas not exceeding 100 feet in length in which the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles would create an especially hazardous condition or would cause unusual delay to traffic.

b. When official signs are erected at hazardous or congested places as authorized herein, no person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle in any such designated place.

**SECTION 8. BOROUGH SECRETARY TO DESIGNATE CURB LOADING ZONES.**

a. The Borough Secretary shall not hereafter designate or sign any curb loading zone upon special request of any person unless such person makes application for a permit for such curb loading zone with the Borough Secretary and for two signs to indicate the ends of each such curb loading zone. Unless such request shall constitute a hazard or risk to the public safety and welfare, the Borough Secretary will grant a permit and issue such signs after payment by the applicant and deposit in the Borough treasury of a service fee of \$60.00 per year, which said fee may be adjusted from time to time by Borough Council. The Borough Secretary may, by general regulations, impose conditions upon the use of such signs for the curb loading zone. As may be applicable, the Borough Secretary may seek an additional service fee from the applicant for the reimbursement of the Borough for the value of said signs in the event of their loss or damage and their return in the event of misuse or upon expiration of the permit. Every permit shall expire at the end of one (1) year, and must be renewed by the applicant for each one-year term.

b. No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle for any purpose or length of time other than for the expeditious unloading and delivery or pickup and loading of materials in any place marked as a curb loading zone during hours when the provisions applicable to such curb loading zones are in effect. In no case shall a person stop, stand or park for loading or unloading of materials for a period in excess of thirty (30) minutes.

**SECTION 9. STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING OF TAXICABS.**

a. The operator of a taxicab shall not stop, stand or park such vehicle upon any street at any place other than in a taxicab stand so designated as provided herein. This provision shall not prevent the operator of a taxicab from temporarily stopping in accordance with other stopping or parking regulations at any place for the purpose of and while actually engaged in the expeditious loading or unloading of passengers.

b. The Borough shall designate appropriate areas and locations, from time to time, throughout the municipality for such taxicab stands in the Borough's sole discretion.

## **SECTION 10. RESTRICTED USE OF TAXICAB STANDS**

a. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle other than a taxicab in a taxicab stand when any such stop or stand has been officially designated and appropriately signed, except that the driver of a passenger vehicle may temporarily stop, stand or park therein for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading passengers when such stopping, standing or parking does not interfere with any taxicab waiting to enter or about to enter such taxicab stand.

## **SECTION 11. UNATTENDED VEHICLES.**

a. No person shall leave a vehicle unattended while the motor of such vehicle is still running; and no vehicle shall be left without a driver on any hill or incline unless the vehicle is properly secured against further movement.

## **SECTION 12. STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING RESTRICTED OR PROHIBITED ON CERTAIN STREETS.**

a. The provisions of this section prohibiting the stopping, standing or parking of a vehicle shall apply at all times or at those times herein specified or as indicated on official signs except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other vehicles or traffic or in compliance with the direction of a police officer or official traffic-control devices.

b. The provisions of this section imposing a time limit on parking shall not relieve any person from the duty to observe other and more restrictive provisions prohibiting or limiting the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles in specified places at specified times.

c. As set forth in this Ordinance or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule I attached to and made a part of this Ordinance.

d. As set forth in this Ordinance or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle between the hours specified in Schedule II of any day within the Borough or upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in said Schedule II attached to and made a part of this Ordinance.

e. As set forth in this Ordinance or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, parking will be prohibited on alternate sides of the streets on alternate days of the week, on the streets or parts of streets designated in Schedule III attached to and made a part of this Ordinance. Such signs will specify that parking is prohibited on every Monday, Wednesday and Friday on one side of the street and is prohibited every Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday on the opposite side of the street. The parking prohibition for such streets shall not be in effect from 9:00 p.m. through 4:00 a.m. of each day.



f. As set forth in this Ordinance or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle on any streets or parts of streets in violation of the regulations set forth in Schedule IV attached to and made a part of this Ordinance.

g. As set forth in this Ordinance or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle from 12:01 a.m. on November 15 of each year through 11:59 p.m. on April 15 of each year on any streets or parts of streets described in Schedule V, which is attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance.

h. As set forth in this Ordinance or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle from 12:01 a.m. on November 15 of each year through 11:59 p.m. on April 15 of each year for a period of time and on any streets or parts of streets described in Schedule VI, which is attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

i. Specified parking restrictions imposed by this ordinance may be temporarily lifted upon application of a Borough of Union City community related organization, and upon approval by Borough Council, so long as the lifting of such restrictions are limited to one side of each street. The Borough of Union City Borough Council shall, in its discretion, approve such requests by motion at a properly advertised public meeting.

### **SECTION 13. PARKING SIGNS REQUIRED**

a. Whenever by this or any other ordinance of this Borough any parking time limit is imposed or parking is prohibited on designated streets, it shall be the duty of the Borough Secretary, in consultation with the Borough Chief of Police, to direct the placement and erection of appropriate signs giving notice thereof.

### **SECTION 14. PENALTIES.**

a. The fact that a vehicle which is illegally stopped, standing or parked is registered in the name of a person shall be considered *prima facie* proof that such person was in control of the vehicle at the time of such stopping, standing or parking.

b. Any person accused of a violation of or found in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance may settle and compromise the claim against him or her for such illegal stopping, standing or parking by paying to the Borough the amount and on the schedule established, from time to time, by resolution of the borough council. A receipt shall be issued for all money so received and such money shall be turned over monthly to the Treasurer of the Borough to be used in the manner provided for the disposition of fines for traffic violations.

c. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance or aiding, abetting or assisting in the violation of said provisions, shall, upon conviction before the Magisterial District Justice with jurisdiction, be subjected to a fine of not less than twice the amount required to settle the claim established by this Ordinance in Section 14(b) above and as

stated on the parking ticket, nor more than \$300.00, together with the costs of prosecution and, in default thereof, said convicted person may undergo imprisonment in the Erie County prison for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days.

d. An illegally parked vehicle may be towed by the Union City Police Department, or the Borough Street Supervisor, or their designee, at the expense of the owner, after and upon the receipt of two (2) parking tickets within three (3) consecutive days, such violations occurring on the same street.

## **SECTION 15. PROCEDURE OF PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS**

a. The Borough shall provide books to the Borough Parking Enforcement Officers which include parking ticket forms for notifying alleged violators of the nature of the violation of this Ordinance. Said books shall include serially numbered sets of tickets and shall be in a form established by the Borough Chief of Police in consultation with the Street Supervisor.

b. The Borough Chief of Police will be responsible for the issuance of such books to Parking Enforcement Officers and shall maintain a record showing the disposition of each serially numbered ticket.

c. Every Borough Parking Enforcement Officer upon issuing a ticket to an alleged violator of this Ordinance shall deposit a copy of the ticket with the Borough Chief of Police.

d. Whenever any motor vehicle without a driver is found parked or stopped in violation of the restrictions imposed by this Ordinance, the Parking Enforcement Officer finding such vehicle shall take its registration number and any other information which may identify the vehicle or its owner or user, and shall conspicuously affix to such vehicle a parking ticket for the driver to answer the charge against him or her within 24 hours.

e. If a violator of the restrictions on stopping, standing or parking imposed by this Ordinance does not appear in response to a parking ticket affixed to such vehicle within 24 hours, the Borough Chief of Police shall send to the owner of the vehicle to which the parking citation was affixed a letter informing him or her of the violation and warning him or her that in the event such a letter and citation is disregarded for a period of five (5) days from the date of the letter, a citation charging the alleged violation of this Ordinance will be filed with the District Magistrate having jurisdiction.

## **SECTION 16. EFFECT AND SHORT TITLE OF ORDINANCE**

a. If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

b. This Ordinance specifically repeals Borough Ordinances 965, 969, 971, 979, 1000, 1002, 1008, 1013, 1014, 1016, 1027, 1030, 1041, and 1043 in their entireties and all other ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

c. The Borough Secretary shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in this Borough.

d. This Ordinance may be known and cited as the “Union City Borough Parking Ordinance.”

e. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment.

**SECTION 17. SCHEDULES OF DESIGNATED STREETS REFERRED TO IN THIS ORDINANCE.**

a. The Schedules of this Ordinance and referred to herein are attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

**SCHEDULE I**

**Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets or Parts of Streets.**

In accordance with Section 12(c) or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Bank Street	Entire length.
Bridge Street	Entire length.
Concord Street	Entire length.
East High Street	From Warden Street east to Borough Limit. Also, on the north side of the street from the intersection with North Main Street east to a point a distance of 435 feet, and on the south side of the street from its intersection with North Main Street to a point a distance of 368 feet east.
First Avenue	North of West High Street.
Fourth Avenue	From South Street 300 feet south of South Street.
Hemlock Street	From Concord Street north to Pleasant Street.
Heath Alley	Entire length.
Hogan's Alley	Entire length.
Hunter Avenue	Entire length.
Jackson Street	Entire length south side of street.
John Street	Entire length.
Liberty Street	Entire length.
Lincoln Street	From Concord Street 400 feet south.

In accordance with Section 12(c) or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Perry Street	Entire length.
Second Avenue	South Main Street to West High Street
Short Street	Entire length.

**SCHEDULE II**

**Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets.**

In accordance with Section 12(d) or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle between the hours specified herein of any day within the Borough or upon any street or parts of streets as follows:

Jackson Street	No Parking on the south side for the entire length of street. Diagonal parking is permitted on the north side for the entire length of street.
Market Street	Parking where permitted shall be limited to 2 hours in duration.
New Street	No parking the entire length from the 15 <sup>th</sup> of November through the 15 <sup>th</sup> of April. No parking on the north side, entire length, from the 16 <sup>th</sup> of April through the 14 <sup>th</sup> of November.
North Main Street	From the bridge north to East High Street on both of the east and west sides of the street, parking is limited to 2 hours in duration where permitted.
Putnam Street	No Parking on the north side from Warden Street to North Main Street.
Second Avenue	No parking, except on the west side from South Main Street to a point 300 feet south of South Street.
East High Street	Except as provided in Schedule VI, on the north side of the street from its intersection with Warden Street to a point of distance of 265 feet west, and on the south side of the street from its intersection with Warden Street to a point of distance of 356 feet west , parking is limited to four hours in duration where permitted.

In accordance with Section 12(f) or where signs are erected giving notice thereof, special parking regulations on certain streets or parts of streets shall be as follows:

Annual permits are available from the Borough Secretary at a cost to be determined, from time-to-time, by Resolution of the Borough Council. No overnight parking is permitted from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. every day of the week during and including the period from the 15 <sup>th</sup> of November through the 15 <sup>th</sup> of April. All other parking in Municipal Lot One is limited to 4 hours in duration in designated areas. All vehicles parking in Municipal Lot One shall park with the front pulled into the parking space. Backing into a parking space is not permitted. |

**SCHEDULE IV (CONTINUED)**

In accordance with Section 12(f) or where signs are erected giving notice thereof, special parking regulations on certain streets or parts of streets shall be as follows:

Municipal Lot Two      Located between Market Street and French Creek and North Main Street and the property belonging to the Union City Chair and other private property shall have overnight parking by permit in the spaces located on the east side of the parking lot. Annual permits are available from the Borough Secretary at a cost to be determined, from time-to-time, by Resolution of the Borough Council. Permits shall be available for Borough residents (proof of residency will be required) and only for legally registered vehicles. Permitted vehicles must be moved at least once per week. No overnight parking is permitted for recreational vehicles. No overnight parking is permitted from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. every day of the week during and including the period from the 15<sup>th</sup> of November through the 15<sup>th</sup> of April. All other parking in Municipal Lot Two is limited to 4 hours in duration in designated areas. All vehicles parking in Municipal Lot Two shall park with the front pulled into the parking space. Backing into a parking space is not permitted.
