ORDINANCE NO. 1171**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY,  
COUNTY OF ERIE, COMMONWEALTH OF  
PENNSYLVANIA; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 1137, AS  
AMENDED, GENERALLY KNOWN AS THE PARKING  
ORDINANCE, RESTRICTING PARKING OF UNLAWFUL  
AND DISABLED VEHICLES, AMENDING SCHEDULES I, II  
AND IV, MAKING CERTAIN TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS  
TO THE SCHEDULES, AND AMENDING PARKING  
RESTRICTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY,  
REPEALER AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the Pennsylvania Borough Code, at 8 Pa.C.S. §1202(31), provides that the Union City Borough (the “Borough”) is authorized to regulate the parking of motor vehicles within its jurisdictional area; and

**WHEREAS**, on or about June 8, 2021, the Borough adopted Ordinance No. 1137, colloquially known as the Union City Borough Parking Ordinance (the “Parking Ordinance”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council desires to amend Ordinance 1137 as it pertains to overnight parking in the Municipal Parking Lots, and to make certain other minor corrections; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council finds that the amendment of the Parking Ordinance will be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the Borough.

**NOW THEREFORE**, on this 16th day of September, 2024, **BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Union City, Erie County, Pennsylvania as follows:

1. Recitals. The recitals listed above are incorporated as if more fully set forth herein.
2. Schedule I. That Schedule I to the Parking Ordinance is amended by the deletion of those terms struck out and the inclusion of those underlined terms, as follows:

**SCHEDULE I**Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets or Parts of Streets.

In accordance with Section 15(c) or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SECTION OF STREET/REGULATION</u>
Bank Street	Entire length.
Bridge Street	Entire length.
Concord Street	Entire length.
East High Street	From Warden Street east to Borough Limit. Also, on the north side of the street from the intersection with North Main Street east to a point a distance of 435 feet, and on the south side of the street from its intersection with North Main Street to a point a distance of 368 feet east.
First Avenue	North of West High Street.
Fourth Avenue	From South Street 300 feet south of South Street.
Hemlock Street	From Concord Street north to Pleasant Street.
Heath Alley	Entire length.
Hogan's Alley	Entire length.
Hunter Avenue	Entire length.
Jackson Street	Entire length south side of street.
John Street	Entire length.
Liberty Street	Entire length.

SCHEDULE I (CONTINUED)Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets or Parts of Streets.

In accordance with Section 15(c) or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SECTION OF STREET/REGULATION</u>
Market Street	No parking on the south side from North Main Street to the entrance to Municipal Lot 2.
Merrill Avenue	Entire length.
Miles Street	From Concord Street to Jackson Street.
North Main Street	From East High Street north to the Borough Limits and from West High Street south to Webbr Alley. Also, on the east side of North Main Street from its intersection with High Street south to a point a distance of 118 feet.
O'dell Street	From Cherry Street to the Borough Limits.
Parade Street	From South Main Street 150 feet west on Parade Street.
Page Street	Entire length.
Perry Street	Entire length.
Second Avenue	South Main Street to West High Street
Short Street	Entire length.
Sixth Avenue	Entire length.
South Main Street	From Concord Street to Meadville <del>Street</del> Road. Also, on the east side from a point approximately 100 feet south of Stranahan Street to Concord Street the bridge, south 232 feet past the Police Department garage, and on the west side of South Main Street to a point 466 548 feet north from its intersection with Second Avenue.

**SCHEDULE I (CONTINUED)**Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets or Parts of Streets.

In accordance with Section 15(c) or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time stop, stand or park a vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Stranahan Street	Entire length.
Terrace Street	Entire length.
Warden Street	From Putnam Street <del>North</del> to <del>North Main Street.</del> <u>John Street</u>
Washington Street	From Erie Lackawanna Railroad crossing to Atlantic Street.
Waterford Street	Entire length.
Wilson Avenue	Entire length.

1. Schedule II. That Schedule II to the Parking Ordinance is amended by the deletion of those terms struck out and the inclusion of those underlined terms, as follows:

**SCHEDULE II**Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets.

In accordance with Section 15(d) or when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle between the hours specified herein of any day within the Borough or upon any street or parts of streets as follows:

<u>NAME OF STREET</u>	<u>SECTION OF STREET/REGULATION</u>
North Main Street	From French Creek north to West High Street from the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.
South Main Street	From <del>French Creek south</del> <u>South Street</u> to Second Avenue from the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.
Market Street	From North Main Street east to end of 2 hour parking zone.

2. Schedule IV. That Schedule IV to the Parking Ordinance is amended by the deletion of those terms struck out and the inclusion of those underlined terms, as follows:

**SCHEDULE IV**

In accordance with Section 15(f) or where signs are erected giving notice thereof, special parking regulations on certain streets or parts of streets shall be as follows:

NAME OF STREET	SECTION OF STREET/REGULATION
Center Street	Alternate-day parking shall be enforced year-round on Center Street.
Fourth Avenue	No parking on the west side from South Street south to the Erie-Lackawanna Railroad Crossing. No parking on the east side from South Street to a point 300 feet south of South Street.
Jackson Street	No Parking on the south side for the entire length of street. Diagonal parking is permitted on the north side for the entire length of street.
Market Street	Parking where permitted shall be limited to 2 hours in duration.
New Street	No parking the entire length from the 15 <sup>th</sup> of November through the 15 <sup>th</sup> of April. No parking on the north side, entire length, from the 16 <sup>th</sup> of April through the 14 <sup>th</sup> of November.
North Main Street	From the bridge north to East High Street on both of the east and west sides of the street, parking is limited to 2 hours in duration where permitted.
Second Avenue	No parking, except on the west side from South Main Street to a point 300 feet south of South Street.
East High Street	Except as provided in Schedule VI, on the north side of the street from its intersection with Warden Street to a point of distance of 265 feet west, and on the south side of the street from its intersection with Warden Street to a point of distance of 356 feet west, parking is limited to four hours in duration where permitted.
South Main Street	From the bridge south to Concord Street on the east and west sides of the street, parking shall be limited to 2 hours in duration where permitted. Except as noted

below no parking shall be permitted on the east side of South Main Street in front of the Borough of Union City Building between the signs as posted. ~~Parking will only be permitted for municipal vehicles for a period of one hour. "Municipal vehicles" shall be defined as any vehicles owned and operated by the Borough of Union City or employees and officials of the Borough of Union City, acting in their employment or official capacity, or members of the public with official business at the City Building.~~

South Street

No Parking from South Main Street to First Avenue.

Warden Street

From East High Street north to Putnam Street, no parking between the 15<sup>th</sup> of November and the 15<sup>th</sup> of April. Parking is permitted on the west side only from April 16 through November 14.

West High Street

No Parking at any time from North Main Street west to Second Avenue.

Municipal Lot One

~~Lot located between North Main Street and West High Street. Overnight parking is permitted by permit in the parking spaces located on the west edge of the lot which abuts French Creek. No overnight parking is permitted for recreational vehicles, including on weekends. Annual permits are available from the Borough Manager at a cost to be determined, from time to time, by Resolution of the Borough Council. Permits shall be available for Borough residents (proof of residency will be required) and only for legally registered vehicles. Drivers must submit their drivers' license, proof of insurance, inspection, and registration in order to receive a permit for Municipal Lot One.~~

~~Overnight parking is permitted from 12:01 a.m. on Saturdays through 11:59 p.m. on Sundays.~~

~~Permitted vehicles must be moved at least once per week. Except as otherwise provided, no overnight parking is permitted from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. from November 15<sup>th</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.~~

~~All other parking in Municipal Lot One is limited to 4 hours in duration in designated areas. All vehicles parking in Municipal Lot One shall park with the front~~

pulled into the parking space. Backing into a parking space is not permitted. Owners will only be permitted to park two (2) vehicles per drivers' license in Municipal Lot One.

Lot located between North Main Street and West High Street.

Overnight parking is permitted by permit only in the parking spaces located on the west edge of the lot which abuts French Creek. No unpermitted overnight parking is permitted elsewhere except from 11:00 p.m. on Fridays through 11:59 p.m. on Sundays. At no point may recreational vehicles be parked overnight. For purposes of this provision, overnight parking is considered to be between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m.

Annual overnight parking permits are available from the Borough Manager at a cost to be determined, from time-to-time, by Resolution of the Borough Council. Permits shall be available for Borough residents (proof of residency will be required) and only for legally registered vehicles. Drivers must submit their drivers' license, proof of insurance, inspection, and registration in order to receive a permit for Municipal Lot One. Permitted vehicles must be moved at least once per week.

All other parking in Municipal Lot One is limited to 4 hours in duration in designated areas. All vehicles parking in Municipal Lot One shall park with the front pulled into the parking space. Backing into a parking space is not permitted. Owners will only be permitted to park two (2) vehicles per drivers' license in Municipal Lot One.

## Municipal Lot Two

Located between Market Street and French Creek and North Main Street and private property shall have overnight parking by permit in the spaces located on the east side of the parking lot. Annual permits are available from the Borough Manager at a cost to be determined, from time to time, by Resolution of the Borough Council. Permits shall be available for Borough residents (proof of residency will be required) and only for legally registered vehicles. Drivers must submit their drivers' license, proof of insurance, inspection, and registration in order to receive a permit for Municipal Lot Two.

Overnight parking is permitted from 12:01 a.m. on Saturdays through 11:59 p.m. on Sundays.

Permitted vehicles must be moved at least once per week. No overnight parking is permitted for recreational vehicles, including on weekends. Except as otherwise provided, no overnight parking is permitted from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. from November 15<sup>th</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. All other parking in Municipal Lot Two is limited to 4 hours in duration in designated areas. All vehicles parking in Municipal Lot Two shall park with the front pulled into the parking space. Backing into a parking space is not permitted. Owners will only be permitted to park two (2) vehicles per drivers' license in Municipal Lot Two.

Located between Market Street and French Creek and North Main Street and private property.

Overnight parking is permitted by permit only in the parking spaces located on the on the east side of the parking lot. No unpermitted overnight parking is permitted elsewhere except from 11:00 p.m. on Fridays through 11:59 p.m. on Sundays. At no point may recreational vehicles be parked overnight. For purposes of this provision, overnight parking is considered to be between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m.

Annual overnight parking permits are available from the Borough Manager at a cost to be determined, from time-to-time, by Resolution of the Borough Council. Permits shall be available for Borough residents (proof of residency will be required) and only for legally



registered vehicles. Drivers must submit their drivers' license, proof of insurance, inspection, and registration in order to receive a permit for Municipal Lot Two. Permitted vehicles must be moved at least once per week.

All other parking in Municipal Lot Two is limited to 4 hours in duration in designated areas. Backing into a parking space is not permitted. Owners will only be permitted to park two (2) vehicles per drivers' license in Municipal Lot Two.

## Municipal Lot Three

Annual permits are available from the Borough Manager at a cost to be determined, from time-to-time, by Resolution of the Borough Council. Permits shall be available for Borough residents (proof of residency will be required) and only for legally registered vehicles. Drivers must submit their drivers' license, proof of insurance, inspection, and registration in order to receive a permit for Municipal Lot Three.

Permitted vehicles must be moved at least once per week. No overnight parking is permitted for recreational vehicles. Except as otherwise provided, no overnight parking is permitted from 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. from November 15<sup>th</sup> through April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. All other parking in Municipal Lot Three is limited to 4 hours in duration in designated areas. All vehicles parking in Municipal Lot Two shall park with the front pulled into the parking space. Backing into a parking space is not permitted. Owners will only be permitted to park two (2) vehicles per drivers' license in Municipal Lot Three.

Located along South Main Street across the street from the Union City Library.

Overnight parking is permitted by permit only in the parking spaces located on the on the west side of the parking lot, where designated. No unpermitted overnight parking is permitted elsewhere except from 11:00 p.m. on Fridays through 11:59 p.m. on Sundays. At no point may recreational vehicles be parked overnight. For purposes of this provision, overnight parking is considered to be between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m.

Annual overnight parking permits are available from the Borough Manager at a cost to be determined, from time-to-time, by Resolution of the Borough Council. Permits shall be available for Borough residents (proof of residency will be required) and only for legally registered vehicles. Drivers must submit their drivers' license, proof of insurance, inspection, and registration in order to receive a permit for Municipal Lot Three. Permitted vehicles must be moved at least once per week.

All other parking in Municipal Lot Three is limited to 4 hours in duration in designated areas. Backing into a parking space is not permitted. Owners will only be permitted to park two (2) vehicles per drivers' license in Municipal Lot Three.

3. Repealer. Any Ordinances, rules, or resolutions, or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.


4. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any sentence clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Borough Council that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.


5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its proper execution by the Borough Mayor or as soon as may be otherwise permitted by applicable law.

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
